

**Class Name:** Reversible Purse

**Supplies Needed:**

**Pattern:** Versatile Wave Interchangeable Purse Pattern by Ruthann Stilwell

**Basic purse, lining, pockets & Straps:**

- Fabric A, basic purse & lining = 1 yard – if you are making your lining from a different fabric, you will need 2/3 yard for basic purse and 1/2 yard for lining (refer to back of pattern)
- Recommended batting for purse & straps (Soft & Stable or Thermolam) – 3/4 yard – this is foam like batting for a sturdier base

**Fabric for each reversible purse cover:**

- Fabric B: 1/3 yard or fat quarter
- Fabric C: 1/3 yard or fat quarter
- Fusible Interfacing: 3/4 yard Pellon 809 Décor Bond or comparable

**Notions**

- 14" regular or separating sport zipper – or - 12" purse zipper
- 4 swivel clasps (to accommodate 1 1/4" straps) – Susan Rooney brand works great and are at Quilt Crossing
- 2 large buttons (approximately 1" size)
- Single fold bias tape (for purse cover loops) – or - can use 1/4 yard of 3/8" trim
- Thread to match
- 505 Adhesive Spray
- Seam guide (usually comes with sewing machine and/or with a walking foot)

**Additional Supplies:**

- Sewing machine in good running condition (please bring your manual)
- Misc. sewing supplies
- 6" metal sewing gauge
- Chalk marker
- If you have a Bernina Sewing Machine, the following feet are useful for this project: 1C (General Purpose); 4 or 4D zipper foot; 10/10C or 10D – Edgestitch foot; 3A – Buttonhole foot
