Supplies Needed:

We will be hand stitching a piece to create a place mat.

Fabric: ½ yard of a loosely woven natural fiber fabric. Homespun cotton, flannel, and linen are good choices. The stitching will show up better on a solid or almost solid color. Cottons such as Batiks are woven too tightly for this technique.

Pearl cotton thread in a color to contrast with your fabric. I used #5.

Large eyed embroidery needle for your pearl cotton thread

Scissors

Thimble, if you use one

Dressmaker tracing paper and tracing wheel

Ballpoint pen

Pins

Optional but helpful supplies:

If you own a sandpaper board or non-slip surface for tracing designs on fabric, please bring it.
