

Class Name: Scrappy Applique Class

Instructor: Jane Sparrell

Supplies Needed:

- Shannon Brinkley Pattern for Applique Project – Choose from a cat, bear, fox, horse or bunny (Jane will work with you to order this prior to class.)
- **Fabric for Collage and Background**
 - o **8-12 fat eighths** – use monochromatic prints (Use 100% cotton fabric for collage fabric - Choose variety of colors/patterns for the collage, including a variety of solids, textured solids, batiks and monochromatic (all or mostly one color) prints. Do not include more than one or two prints with negative (white) space because they tend to break up the collage. Pre-wash fabric prior to class.
- **Background Fabric** – 5/8 Yard of solid or a simple print (so it will not detract from collage)
- **Pillow Fabric**
 - 5/8 Yard for back of pillow
 - 5/8 Yard of Muslin
 - 22" x 22" piece of batting
 - Thread for quilting and satin stitching
 - 18" Square Pillow Form
- Add a contrasting color of fabric as well (one across the color wheel from the others.)
- Pellon 906F Interfacing – Shear weight, nonwoven fusible interfacing
- Sulky Totally Stable Iron On Tear Away Stabilizer
- Thread to match your collage fabrics
- Applique Press Sheet and Parchment paper (please bring both)
- Dritz Fray Check
- Bobbin weight thread (60 or 90 weight) – for topstitching
- Grip gloves – Machinigers work great!
- Free Motion Quilting Foot
- Basic Sewing Supplies (small iron and ironing surface, small cutting mat and rotary cutter, fabric scissors (large and small))
- Chalk marking tool or micron pen for tracing smaller, finer design
- Sewing machine in good running order
- New machine needles – Sizes 70/11 for topstitching and 80/12 or 90/14 for satin stitching
- Open Toe applique foot (On Bernina, foot #20)
- Free motion quilting foot

Optional but helpful supplies:

- The book, **Scrappy Bits Applique by Shannon Brinkley** is a great reference tool for the process.
