

Class Name: Merry Christmas Stocking

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine with a ¼" foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table, and knee lift)
- Embroidery module with embroidery foot
- Size 80/12 sewing needles
- Merry Christmas pattern. You will need to print the detailed instructions on the CD.
- Rotary cutter
- Medium sized cutting mat if you want to do your trimming at your sewing station
- Ruler for cutting fabric strips (24 x 6 or 6 ½" works best)
- .55mm Flower Head or .5mm 1 7/8" Glass head pins (long shanks)
- Thread scissors
- Seam ripper
- Fabric Supply List: (for each stocking)
 - ½ yard background fabric light colored tone on tone for stocking front and back
 - ½ yard lining fabric for front and back lining
 - 12"x18" cuff fabric
 - ¾ yard fusible woven interfacing by OESD or Shape Flex 101 by Pellon
 - 7" of ¼" grosgrain ribbon for stocking hangar
 - Optional 50" of striped or dot fabric for piping. This is cut 1 ¼" wide on the bias
 - Optional 1/8" cording 50" long
 - Optional Piping Hot Binding Tool by Susan K. Cleveland for trimming the piping
 - If you choose to do the piping, the Bernina Foot #30 works well
- Embroidery Supply List
 - Hoop requirements: stitch field must be 7.5" wide by 11" high or larger and bring your largest hoop
 - Grid/template for your hoop
 - Medium Weight Tear Away (5 yards) – OESD Ultra Clean and Tear works well
 - Temporary Adhesive Spray
 - Removable fabric marking pen (thin tip and not air erasable)
 - Terial Magic Starch (mandatory)
 - Arrow shaped Post It notes

- Bobbin thread in a neutral color
- Embroidery thread colors (Isacord 40 weight colors noted below)
