

Class Name: Sun Hats for Boys and Girls

Supplies Needed:

- Machine in good running order
- Book: Children's Sun Hats (Love to Sew) by Gillian Stratton (available at Quilt Crossing)
- Misc. Sewing Supplies (scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.)
- Fabric and interfacing requirements:
 - Bicycle Hat (Baseball Cap): $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of focus fabric; fat quarter for lining; $\frac{1}{8}$ yard of $\frac{3}{8}$ " elastic; $\frac{1}{3}$ yard medium interfacing; $\frac{1}{4}$ yard heavy weight interfacing for brim; thread
 - Strawberry Hat (Sun Hat on page 50): $\frac{1}{2}$ yard focus fabric; $\frac{1}{2}$ yard lining; midweight interfacing; bias binding for flower trim or buttons, etc.
 - Note: You can also do the Sun Visor (page 32), which requires $\frac{1}{2}$ yard fabric; midweight interfacing; $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " in length Velcro strip

Optional but helpful supplies:

- Quilting Guide to make parallel stitching lines on brims
