



**Class Name:** Edge-to-Edge Quilting in the Hoop 101 – Pick Your Panel

**Supplies Required:** (please provide brand if possible)

- Book: Edge-to-Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine by Amelie Scott Designs (includes 10 quilting designs)
- Please have your selected panel, batting & backing quilt sandwich spray based and ready to go. We cannot spray baste in class.
- Please have your template fabric prepared (iron on medium weight pellon to muslin and cut slightly larger than your hoop). You will need to make 2 of these.
- Embroidery machine (700, 770, 790, 880 or equivalent size)
- Largest embroidery hoop (Maxi, Jumbo, or Snap Hoop Monster)
- Slide-on tray
- Bernina embroidery foot #26
- Bernina reverse pattern foot #1C or #1D
- A USB stick to transfer design to your machine
- Snips, pins, etc.
- Thread to quilt with
- 2 full bobbins of your chosen quilting thread
- Dark or black thread for templates
- Fabric or marking pen
- Hand sewing needle

**Optional but helpful supplies:**

- Bernina embroidery foot #15
- Hoop Helper
- Snap Hoop Monster (magnetic embroidery hoop)
- Fray Check
- Clover double-sided ½” basting tape (if not using magnetic hoop)

### Registration

Phone Registrations are taken with a credit card only. **Class fees must be paid at the time of registration.** You are automatically enrolled upon receipt of the class fee, unless notified. Please register early to ensure your place in class. They fill up fast!

Almost every class has a supply list, and they are available both online and in store as well. It is your responsibility to show up for class with the appropriate supplies. We appreciate it when you buy class supplies from us.

Some classes require prep work to be completed prior to start of class. Instructions will be on your supply list. We do love your children, but your fellow students left theirs at home and we hope you do the same.

**Stitch Club** enrollments may be transferred to another Stitch Club class with one week's notice

Due to many people having sensitivity to perfumes and scented lotions, we ask that you do not wear/use any when attending our classes.

### Cancelations

- We hate to say no, but we must commit to our teachers one week before the class begins. Out of town teachers and those teaching multi-day classes or retreats require 30-day notification commitment.
  - 1 Day Classes - Minimum notice of 1 week prior to class.
  - Out of town teachers, Retreats , and multi-day classes are eligible for refunds with at least 3-month notice. 50% Refund with 1-3 months' notice. (unless you/we are able to fill your spot)
