Required Pre Class Prep: To be fully prepared for class, please read through the pattern and fuse the pieces of fabric that you know you will use. Follow the directions for Steam a Seam 2 first fusing that comes with the fusible. Cut your 1 yard of pattern ease into a 36" square.

Supplies Required: (please provide brand if possible)

- Laura Heine's Snow Globe Pattern
- Fabric listed on Snow Globe Pattern Reminder: Come to Class with your fabric fused and separated into the categories listed in the pattern!!
- 1 Yard Pattern Ease foundation
- 8 Yards of 24" wide Steam a Seam 2 or 16 Yards of 12" wide (which is easier to work with)
- Karen K Buckley Medium Perfect Scissors. Please note that this brand of scissors works really well with the Steam a Seam 2 and the serrated edges help cut down on frayed edges
- Applique Pressing Sheet 17 x 24 or Precision Fusing Mat 17 x 24
- #2 Pencil
- Rotary Cutter and Ruler
- Painter's Tape to keep your pattern and pattern ease together
- Notebook and Pen for taking notes
- Phone for taking pictures or Reducing Glass (Door Peephole from a hardware store)

Optional but helpful supplies:

- Stiletto, Purple Thang or Tweezers
- An extra pressing sheet is extremely handy
- Dritz Travel Iron and Wool Pressing Mat (The travel irons draw less current and don't cause Breakers to trip)

We appreciate it when you buy your class supplies from us - these purchases enable us to offer a robust class schedule and keep your dollars local.

*We highly suggest that students bring a travel iron and a wool pressing mat (at least 17" x 17") so they do not have to wait in line for the irons. We recommend the Mighty Steam Iron by Dritz, Steamfast Travel Steam Iron, or the Oliso Mini Project Iron, and we have all of these in stock at The Quilt Crossing. We also suggest that students bring their own cutting mats and rotary cutter because we only supply a limited number. *

You are welcome to send someone in your place if you are unable to come. If enrollment has not met the minimum required for the class, we will cancel it one week before the first session.
