



Class Name: Twister Holiday

Supplies Required:

- Sewing machine with ¼" foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table, and knee lift)
- Size 80/12 sewing needles
- Twister Holiday pattern by Need'I Love
- Tiny Twister Tool
- Fabric (several greens, red, and cream)
- Bow or ribbon to make a bow
- Aurifil thread to blend with fabric
- Iron and pressing mat if you want to sew at your station (see note below)
- Rotary cutters with new blades
- 24" x 24" sized cutting mat to do your trimming at your sewing station
- Quilter's Select or Creative Grid ruler for cutting fabric and templates (24"x6" or 6 1/2" works well)
- Pencil
- Pins
- Thread scissors (Havel's or Kai work well)
- Seam ripper

To eliminate waiting for an iron in the classroom, we suggest that students bring a travel iron and a wool pressing mat (at least 17" x 17"). We recommend the Mighty Steam Iron by Dritz, Steamfast Travel Steam Iron, or the Oliso Mini Project Iron. All of these in stock at The Quilt Crossing.

Pre-Class Instructions:

Please read through the pattern. Feel free to use as many green, red, and cream fabrics as you like. I choose to have my background all one color. I used 1 red and 5 green fabrics. Prior to class, sew the quilt top following the instructions in the pattern. We will begin using the Tiny Twister Tool in class.

Cancellation Policy: We must commit to our teachers and to other students one week before the class begins so we can't give refunds or transfers after that time (unless we can fill your spot from the waiting list). You are welcome to send someone in your place if you are unable to come. If enrollment has not met the minimum required for the class, we will cancel it one week before the first session.
