Optional Layout

- We will make 16 blocks of Hunter's Star in two colors as pictured above. Students will master the use of the Rapid Fire Hunter's Star tool from Studio 180 Design.
- There are over 40 different layouts you may select from or come up with a new one.
- You will have enough blocks for either a table runner or topper, depending upon your layout.

Required tool: Rapid Fire Hunter's Star cost is \$26.50 plus tax **Included in class fee.**

Basic Quilting Tools to bring to the Workshop:

Cutting mat

Rotary cutter, with a good blade

A straight-edge ruler of at least 12" in length

Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, thread, etc.

Fabric Requirements

- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard each of two (2) contrasting fabrics for the center of the quilt.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard for the inner border
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for the outer border

Note: When you find your "inspirational" fabric, be sure that the second fabric has a strong contrast to the point in which it may even read as a solid just to be safe for your first project.


Cutting Instructions

It will be helpful if you have your fabric cut prior to attending the workshop. Then you can spend most of your time sewing.



Optional Layout

From **each** fabric cut the following:

- 8 7" squares; sub cut once on the diagonal
to make 16 half triangles 
- 3 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips
- 3 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips



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
