

## Cork Compass Bag Class

**DO NOT CUT OUT CORK.** We will do this in class

- Compass Bag pattern by Noodlehead
- Sewing machine in good working order
  - Walking foot recommended
  - Zipper foot
  - Size 90/14 topstitch needle
- Cork (exterior fabric) according to pattern (cork does not come in same widths as quilting cotton)
- Lining fabric
- ShapeFlex 101 for lining fabric. No need to interface cork so no canvas or fusible fleece.
- Polyester thread to match cork and lining fabric (do NOT use cotton thread)
- Wonder clips
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, 6"x24" ruler
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Fabric glue (like Fabric-Tac)
- Turning tool to push out corners
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide Wonder tape or fusible web
- 6" zipper for small bag or 8" zipper for large bag (they can be longer as we can cut them to size)
- Magnetic snap
- (2) 1" D-rings
- (2) 1" swivel clasps
- (1) 1" strap slider if wanting to make an adjustable strap
- (12) 8mm double cap rivets (I will have my setting tool)

### Pre-Class Assignment

1. Decide if you are making the small or large bag. Cut out the appropriate pattern pieces. For the cork version I recommend View A for the pockets due to the thickness of the cork.
2. Cut all lining pieces.
3. Cut all interfacing for the lining pieces
4. Fuse interfacing to lining pieces.
5. DO NOT CUT OUT CORK PIECES! We will do this in class
