

Easy appliqué and serger crochet

Happy Halloween Runner

You will serger and sewing machine to complete this project

- 1-Trace pattern onto paper side of fusible.
- 2-Fuse to fabric.
- 3-Cut out appliqué pieces and fuse to runner.
- 4-Appliqué down with your choice of stitches. I use zig-zag with a width of 3.0 length .05.
- 5-Serge along long edges. Press 1/4" under and top stitch.

Serger Crochet

Set serger for basic 4 thread overcast

Left & Right needle with regular serger thread

Upper looper & lower looper with heavy decorative thread(pearl crown cotton)

*stitches are formed by serging first row and flipping to then run next row with only your needles diving into the previous stitch. You then continue until you have the desired amount.

- 1-Begin serging a 3" serger tail.
- 2-Place runner right side up under your serger foot. Swing the thread tail around to the front in order that you may serge over the tail to lock your stitch.
- 3-Now you will run your first row of stitching. Flip and serge again with only the needles diving into the previous serge stitch. When you approach the end you'll simply flip it again and continue until you have your desired length. Have fun and remember the full video is on you tube.
