Kimberbell inspired "Tea Envelope"
Using Bella Box design "Enchanted"

Combine this darling design with the functional yet beautiful tea envelope that fits perfectly in any purse. Let's the daintiest of us have our refreshment anywhere desired. Your friends will love it and you'll use your built in decorative stitches to make it truly personal. Here is what you'll need. If you by chance, missed out on the limited quantity of "Bella Boxes" replace design with any choice of designs with a size of 3 1/2". And next time BUY THE BOX!

Right Ha Ha

1/3 yard of cotton fabric

Threads

Stabilizer for embroidery "Peel n Stick"

I used Floriani embroidery thread #PF 384 it was a perfect match for the Kimberbell cup

Please cut:

2 @ 12 1/2" by 10" one lining and outer fabric

1 @ 4 1/2" by 10 lower pocket fold in half the long way and press

1 @ 5 1/2" by 10 upper pocket fold in half the long way and press

1-Apply decorative stitches at top fold of both pockets.

2-Embroider outer 12 1/2" piece.

3-Lay lining right side up and measure 8 1/4" from bottom, draw a line and place the larger pockets raw edges against this line with right side of pocket down. Stitch a scant 1/4" from edge and flip. Press and position lower pocket in place matching all raw edges at bottom. Draw stitching lines for tea bag pockets and stitch as desired.

4-Place right sides together and transfer pattern for envelope front to envelope and stitch. Be sure to leave an opening to turn. You will hand stitch closed later.

5-Turn and press. I then added a decorative stitch around the front to accent the embroidery. Hand stitch closed and have a cup of Tea.
