

Row by Row Zippered Pouch

Materials:

1 Carolina Sew n Vac License Plate	Batting for front and back
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Row by Row House fabric	Wonder Clips
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Row by Row Blue Fabric	9" or longer zipper

Cutting:

Trim License Plate $\frac{1}{4}$ " from outside edge of License Plate. Measures $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4".

Cut 2" strip of Row by Row fabric - sub cut to (2) 2 " x $7\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Sew to top and bottom of License Plate. This will be the front of the zippered pouch. Press away from License Plate. It should measure $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7".

Cut 2 solid Row by Row fabric $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" - this will be the lining.

Cut 1 Row by Row fabric $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" - this will be the back of the pouch.

Cut batting slightly bigger than $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" - quilt front and back of pouch and then trim to size.

Assembly:

Lay front of pouch right side (RS) up.

Lay zipper RS down with zipper pull to left.

Lay 1 lining RS down. Secure with Wonder clips. Stitch with zipper foot.

Press lining and front of pouch away from zipper. Top stitch along zipper to keep fabric away from zipper.

Lay back of pouch RS up.

Lay zipper RS down. Zipper pull will now be to the right and outside fabric will be RS together (RST).

Lay 1 lining RS down. Lining fabrics will be RST. Secure with Wonder clips. Stitch with zipper foot.

Press lining and front away from zipper. Top stitch along zipper to keep fabric away from zipper.

Unzip zipper.

Position lining fabric RST. Position outside fabric RST. Squish zipper teeth towards lining fabric.

Stitch around all sides, starting at lining bottom, leaving an opening in lining bottom to turn right side out. Back stitch at start and end. Clip corners.

Turn thru opening. Stitch opening closed. Push lining down into pouch. Press.
