

Sewing Machine Cover PLUS

Before I began I decided we need to keep in mind where to stitch through for our bend. I allowed the back side of my machine dictate where that first stitching line would be. The second stitching line was dictated by where I wanted my cover to hang from the table top.

You will need:

Foam

Fabric

Vinyl

Decor Bond

Ribbon or Fabric ties for sides

Cut

Foam at 28 by 20 inches

2 pieces of fabric at 28 by 20 inches

Decor Bond at 7 by 20 inches for pocket

Pocket fabric 14 by 20 inches, go ahead and fuse in Decor Bond and iron a nice crease to form your pocket.

Vinyl 4 by 20 inches and I added a strip of binding to my top edge for strength and it looks cute.

1-Layer with right sides always facing out. Fabric backing, foam, fabric front, fabric pocket {with Decor Bond} and vinyl pocket. Pin and clip as needed.

2-Serge or stitch by machine all layers before adding binding.

3-Ribbons on sides. For my machine I stitched in at 4 inches up from bottom.

4-Add binding and your all done.
