I'll be teaching a series of three mini quilts; this is the last of three. This fun 18" mini neighborhood centers around a town star. As you work, we'll talk about how to get the perfect points on a half-square triangles and snowball blocks, using a BlocLoc ruler

Materials fee is \$10.00. Class: \$30 for one class or \$75 for all three.

Basic Materials

sewing supplies (neutral thread for piecing, pins, scissors, etc.)

cutting supplies (rotary cutter, mat, small (6 1/2") ruler)

sewing machine—bring one that you know how to work, as there is not sufficient class time to teach this

BlocLoc ruler (for truing up half-square triangles) My favorite is 6.5" square.

Fabrics

Since this is a scrappy quilt, sky is the most fabric required, at 1/4 yard (or large scraps). For the rest bring 1/8 yard or equivalent scraps of:

- variety of yellows (houses and center star)
- reds (roofs)
- greens (trees)
- town square background
- pink for center square
- little bits for windows and doors
- fusible web for fusing the windows and doors to the houses (we stitch them down afterwards, or they can be quilted on). I like SoftFuse Premium, which they sell at the shop, but Steam A Seam 2 is also fine. Bring a press cloth so you won't get goo on the iron.

You'll have a thirty-minute lunch break at 12:30; it's easier to bring your own lunch.
