Mayors Message

We have survived yet another month of this pandemic! Who would have thought that 2020 would have been a year of change? Change is inevitable yet it seems as we are seeing more drastic changes to so many of the things we love. I am happy that our small community has been able to stay virtually Covid free in the sense that there have been no cases confirmed in Ferron. I sincerely hope that we can keep it that way. I Pray that each of you will be healthy and strong as we continue the battle. We have purchased Ferron City face masks (tubular masks). You can pick one up at City Hall during regular hours. Please only take one per individual in your family, and remember they were purchased for Ferron residents only.

We are happy to announce that we will have a small-scale Peach Day Celebration this year. After 121 years of celebrating we are not about to let Covid "rain on our parade!! Please look at the schedule included with this mailing and be aware of the events and times that they will be taking place. We encourage you to participate at your own comfort level. Rest assured that we will have sanitizing stations at our events, and we encourage participants to wear masks in situations where social distancing is not possible and as you feel comfortable. We hope that you will find ways to celebrate with us. Our goal was to keep things as normal as possible while still following the mandates and restrictions that have been imposed. Most events will be taking place at the Mayors Park. We encourage you to come and support food vendors and stroll through the car show. We will have a booth near the park where families can purchase t-shirts from last year and/or pick up free bags of candy to enjoy during the parade. We encourage attendance at our popular Field of Flag ceremony, where will have a set of bleachers set up and will welcome lawn chair participants. We will be holding a new event, "Fighting Covid in Color", which will be an opportunity for you to purchase small bags of color powder to throw into the air or on one another as we put the stomp on Covid. This event requires you to wear a mask. You may attend free however, packets of color to throw during the three countdowns will be available for a small cost. This will be a very colorful event so don't expect to stay clean. Saturday evening will conclude our festivities with a light parade. We are counting on you to help us make this parade a great one. The parade route will begin at the Care Center, with the line up at 8:00 pm. We will travel east to the Library and then go south to Canyon Road and then north on 400 west to the San Rafael Middle School. We encourage families to come and be part of the parade by making your own light-up float. Spectators may line the streets along the route to observe the parade. Our Fireworks display will be on Friday night and because of the county fire restrictions it will be held at the fairgrounds park. Please be aware of your pets who may be affected by the loud noises and consider keeping them inside if possible. We were disappointed that the fireworks could not be held at the Lake as planned however we understand the fire danger in that area and support the decision to move it into town. Earlier in the week we will still have our sidewalk chalk contest, bike ride, fun run, exhibit display, outdoor movie, and some virtual games. There is no better time to come together and celebrate our great community and our success in making the most of a hard time.

It will link you to the Utah Air Quality web page where you fill out the permit. If you are unable to do the permit on your own, please call or come to city hall and we will be happy to help you. It is important that you have a permit. If you do not have one and your fire gets away from you, you may be responsible for any costs incurred in fighting the fire.
