I am Writing this newsletter as my last. I have spent the past over 8 years serving the community I love and live in. I have enjoyed the past and present city council members who I have had the opportunity to serve with. Thanks for your support for me over the past years.

Now for a few reminders.

We are still having issues with dogs running around town. Please keep your pets at home. The city does have ordinances against dogs running at large. If your dog gets picked up, we try to give you one free chance. After that there are fees that have to be paid each time your dog is picked up. The fines will double for every time your dog continues to be picked up.

Also, we are starting to enforce all the ordinances we can. The mayor has said "why have them if we are not going to enforce them."

This also goes for burning out of season. We have several issues with this one this spring and winter. The burn window is different for the farmers and those who don't live in the city limits. This is a Utah state law not a city law. The window to burn is now open. If you have questions on whether it is open or not the city can't issue a burn permit out of season. So, try to get one. If you can't it's not open to burn. Also, I have heard several people mention burn barrels. They are illegal to use in city limits out of the burn window.

We have a new Fire Chief. Please be aware that although he has been a fire fighter for several years now, he is learning the ropes of being a good fire chief. We are also looking for a few more fire fighters. If anyone would be interested, please contact city hall.

Please be mindful of fire hydrants that are on your property. There needs to be a 3-foot hydrant clearance around them. Clean all weeds, trees, and other obstacles away from the hydrant.

Again, thanks for supporting me as your city councilman the past years and remember, we live in the best community there is.

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BURN WINDOW

The burn window will open on March 1st through May 30th. Please remember to get a burn permit before burning. There is no charge for the permit. You can receive a permit by going to the city website,

www.ferroncity.org (click on the city documents tab).

It will link you to the Utah Air Quality web page where you fill out the permit. If you are unable to do the permit on your own, please call or come to city hall and we will be happy to help you.

It is important that you have a permit. If you do not have one and your fire gets away from you, you may be responsible for any costs incurred in fighting the fire.

SPRING CLEANUP

There will be roll-off dumpsters placed around the city **in April** for your spring cleanup needs. <u>Please do not use dumpsters at the school, care center, senior citizens, etc.</u> They are for their use only.

If the dumpsters are full,

please take your debris to the

landfill in Castle Dale or call City Hall to have them emptied and wait to put your debris in until there is room.

If you have tree limbs or bushes, please cut them up so they will fit down inside the dumpsters.

Also, do not put the items that are listed in the "Reminder Notice" to the left.
