2019 Arbor Day, Poster Contest and Cleanup

Saturday May 4 has been set aside for Ferron City's annual Arbor Day, poster contest and cleanup. We will meet at the Fairgrounds at 9am. Bring a rake, shovel, 5-gallon bucket, pruners and gloves. This year, Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands Arborist Daniel Allen will be putting on a tree pruning demonstration focusing on ornamental trees. Once trained, those that want to practice can continue to prune trees at designated locations. We will also be scattering mulch around trees and cleaning Ferron and Molen cemeteries in preparation for Memorial Day. Watch for additional information explaining the annual poster contest or contact city hall. Posters will be judged, and prizes awarded on Arbor Day.

SPRING CLEANUP

There will be roll-off dumpsters placed around the city **in April** for your spring cleanup needs. Please do not use dumpsters at the school, care center, senior citizens, etc. They are for their use only.
