### DOG LICENSES

All dog licenses are now past due. If you have not yet licensed your dog, please do so. If the dog is picked up there will be a \$45.00 unlicensed dog fee and a deposit of \$100.00 will be required, giving you 10 days to get the dog licensed. A current rabies shot number and date of expiration of shot is needed before a license can be given.

#### 5-1-10: DOGS AT LARGE;

A. Unlawful Acts: It shall be unlawful: 1. For the owner or keeper of any dog to permit such dog to run at large. 2. For an owner of a dog to permit such dog to go upon or be upon the private property of any person without the permission of the owner or person entitled to the possession of such private property.

B. Violation Regardless Of Precautions: The owner of any dog running at large shall be deemed in violation of this section, regardless of the precautions taken to prevent the escape of the dog and to prohibit it from running at large.

C. Declared Nuisance: Any dog running at large in violation of the provisions of this section is hereby declared to be a nuisance and a menace to the public health and safety, and the dog shall be taken up and impounded as provided in this chapter. (1979 Code § 13-244)

**RESOLUTION 2018-9  
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES AND  
ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE  
FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS**

WHEREAS, Ferron City has a need for a fee schedule regulating the amount of fine to be charged to violators of Ferron City code parking ordinances; and WHEREAS, Ferron City has not had a fee schedule for parking regulation code violations and must adopt one within the city limits of Ferron City,  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following fee schedule shall be adopted by Ferron City.  
Code Section Fee 6-1-4: Parking Regulations

Upon issuing a warning of a parking violation, 10 days will be given to resolve the violation. If the violation has not been resolved within 10 days, a fine of \$50 per day will be charged.

If the violation has not been resolved after an additional 10 days, a fine of \$75 per day will be charged. If the violation has not been resolved after 20 days from the initial citation, it may result in a Class C misdemeanor and upon conviction, subject to penalty as provided in section 1-4-1 of the City code.

**BUSINESS LICENSE**

Business licenses are now past due. Please contact city hall if you have any questions.

**3-1-3: BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIRED;  
PENALTY:**

It shall be a class B misdemeanor, subject to penalty as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code, for any person to establish or carry on any business, trade, profession or calling, to operate a vending, pinball or coin operated machine, to engage in the rental of apartments or trailer spaces, without first receiving the class or type of license required by the city. It shall be unlawful for any person, either directly or indirectly, to continue a business or nonprofit enterprise when a license pertaining thereto has been suspended or revoked. No license shall be issued to a person required to comply with any other law, regulation, or licensing requirements in the conduct of his business or nonprofit enterprise until the applicant demonstrates the fact of such compliance. Compliance with zoning laws is required in all cases. (Ord. 2009-1, 6-25-2009)

**BUILDING PERMITS & ZONING**

Just a reminder on building permits and zoning concerns. According to the International Residential Code R105.1 a building permit is required for *“any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit”*.

Please call city hall if you are doing any building projects to see if a building permit is required and that the proper zoning rules are followed.
