Because of the low cost of scrap metal, Basin Industries has removed their dumpsters. Please do not put any of the above items in the City dumpsters. You will have to take them to the landfill.

We want to remind everyone to be respectful to your neighbors with your dogs. Each household is allowed 3 total dogs. If your dog is outside your yard, by ordinance, it must be on a leash. All dogs are required to be licensed by Ferron City and have a current rabies shot.

If your dog bites someone or another animal, it may be deemed vicious. You may loose the right to own that dog.



BURN WINDOW


The burn window will open on September 15th through November 15th.

Please remember to get a burn permit before burning. You can receive a permit by going to the city website,

www.ferroncity.org

(click on the city documents tab).

It will link you to the Utah Air Quality web page where you fill out the permit. If you are unable to do the permit on your own, please call or come to city hall and we will be happy to help you. It is important that you have a permit. If you do not have one and your fire gets away from you, you may be responsible for any costs incurred in fighting the fire.
