It will link you to the Utah Air Quality web page where you fill out the permit. If you are unable to do the permit on your own, please come in or call the city hall and we will be happy to help you. It is important that you have a permit. If you do not have one and your fire gets away from you, you may be responsible for any cost incurred in fighting the fire.
