In Embroidery Club this month we will be making the "Fresh Poppies" wall hanging. Students will learn how to successfully complete a tiling scene and embroider with a raw edge applique method. In class you will have time to make about 4 blocks. There will be homework needed to complete the project. Fabric kits are available for this project. Please see the pre-class prep work listed below.

1/3 yd. light green fabric (upper background embroidered tiles)

1/3 yd. medium green fabric (middle background embroidered tiles)

1/3 yd. dark green fabric (lower background embroidered tiles)

1/8 vd. darker green fabric (leaves)

1/8 yd. deep red fabric (poppy applique)

1/8 yd. red orange fabric (poppy applique)

1/8 yd. orange fabric (poppy applique)

1/3 yd. or 12" x 27" piece cotton batting

1/8 yd. binding fabric

1/3 yd. backing fabric

OESD Fusible Woven*

OESD Applique Fuse and Fix*

OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth*

Prep work to be finished before class:

- 1. Print out mirrored image designs on OESD Applique Fuse and Fix. The mirrored images will be emailed to you as they are not in the PDF. Make sure you are printing on the paper side of the sheets. Rough cut out all the pieces.
- 2. Label your fabrics. Light, medium, dark green, light, medium, dark orange, and extra dark green for leaves.
- 3. Gather all the supplies and bring to class.
