



For our March project, we are going to make an “in the hoop” project. This means that the wallet will be constructed in the hoop and the last step is sewing an edge stitch around the wallet. We will be using our embroidery tools and our sewing tools to make this fun project. This project will also refresh our in the hoop skills.

Supplies:

OESD In The Hoop Wallets #12631 Pattern**

Isacord Threads*

Matching top thread and bobbin for edge stitch. (I used Isacord thread)*

OESD Lightweight Tear Away Stabilizer*

Organ Sharp 80/12 Needles*

Schmetz Jean Needle 90/14*

For Short Zipper Option:

7” zipper* (I was careful and used the 14” handbag zippers we sell in the store)*

Main Fabric:*

- (1) 3" x 3" for tab
- (1) 5" x 4" (fold and press to 5" x 2") for wallet top
- (1) 5" x 13" (fold and press to 5" x 6.5") for wallet bottom
- (1) 5" x 8" for wallet lining

Contrast Fabric:*

- (2) 5" x 6.5" for longer pocket (fold and press to 5" x 3.25")
- (2) 5" x 5" for shorter pocket (fold and press to 5" x 2.5")
- (1) 5" x 4.5" for zipper pocket lining

For Long Zipper Option:

9” zipper* (I was careful and used the 14” handbag zippers we sell in the store)*

Main Fabric:*

- (1) 3" x 3" for tab
- (1) 8" x 4" (fold and press to 8" x 2") for wallet left
- (1) 8" x 7" (fold and press to 8" x 3.5") for wallet right
- (1) 5" x 8" for wallet lining

Contrast Fabric:*

- (2) 5" x 6.5" for longer pocket (fold and press to 5" x 3.25")
- (2) 5" x 5" for shorter pocket (fold and press to 5" x 2.5")
- (1) 5" x 8" for zipper pocket lining
