*Design Collection: OESD Imperial Gardens #82008

We will be using 38, 39, 40 and 41 but the entire collection is worth having!

*Fabric:

Embroidery background fabric (1) yard. Cut (5): 10" x 14" for oval hoop
You will be hooping the fabric. Cut correct size for the hoop you are using.

1/4 yard decorative fabric. Cut (4): 6" x 6" squares



Backing: 20" x 20"



Binding: 1/4 yard

*Batting: 20" x 20" Warm and Natural

*Hoop: Oval, Midi, or Small Clamp -**Bring Template!**

*OESD Medium Weight Tear Away Stabilizer

*Fusible woven roll or ShapeFlex -1 yard

*Isacord Thread: 1 or more colors that contrast with your background fabric and coordinate with your decorative fabric. The designs are single color.

*Bobbin thread: neutral/white

*Organ Sharp Embroidery Needles 80/12 or 70/11

*Fabric marking chalk or FriXion Pen

*505 spray or stick

Rotary cutter and cutting mat Ruler

*small iron and ironing pad

*OESD press cloth

*Basic Embroidery Supplies

Sewing machine in good working order
with embroidery module, slide on table,
power cord, embroidery foot

Before class:

1. Purchase the designs from Mel's or OESD.
2. Load the designs onto your USB Stick (EXP for Bernina)
3. Cut your background fabric according to your selected hoop size.
4. Fuse Fusible woven or ShapeFlex to the back of each piece of background fabric.
5. On each piece of background fabric, mark vertical and horizontal centers from edge to edge with chalk or Flexion pen.
6. Bring your hoop TEMPLATE to class!
