### **PREP WORK: On your USB stick**

#### **AM**

##### **Background**

Blue quilter's cotton 16" x 18"

Green quilter's cotton 16" x 5"

## **Applique**

Pink quilter's cotton (1) 4 1/2" Square (1) 6" Square

Aqua quilter's cotton (1) 6" x 4" (1) 5" x 5"

Dark Green quilter's cotton (1) 9" x 6"

Dark Pink quilter's cotton (1) 5" x 5"

## **PM**

### **Fabric**

Blue quilter's cotton (4) 7" squares

• White quilter's cotton (2) 5" squares

Apply Fusible Woven to the wrong side of the blue background fabric.

Apply one layer of Fuse and Fleece to the wrong side of the prepared background fabric.

Apply two layers of fuse and fleece to the wrong side of the white applique fabric.
