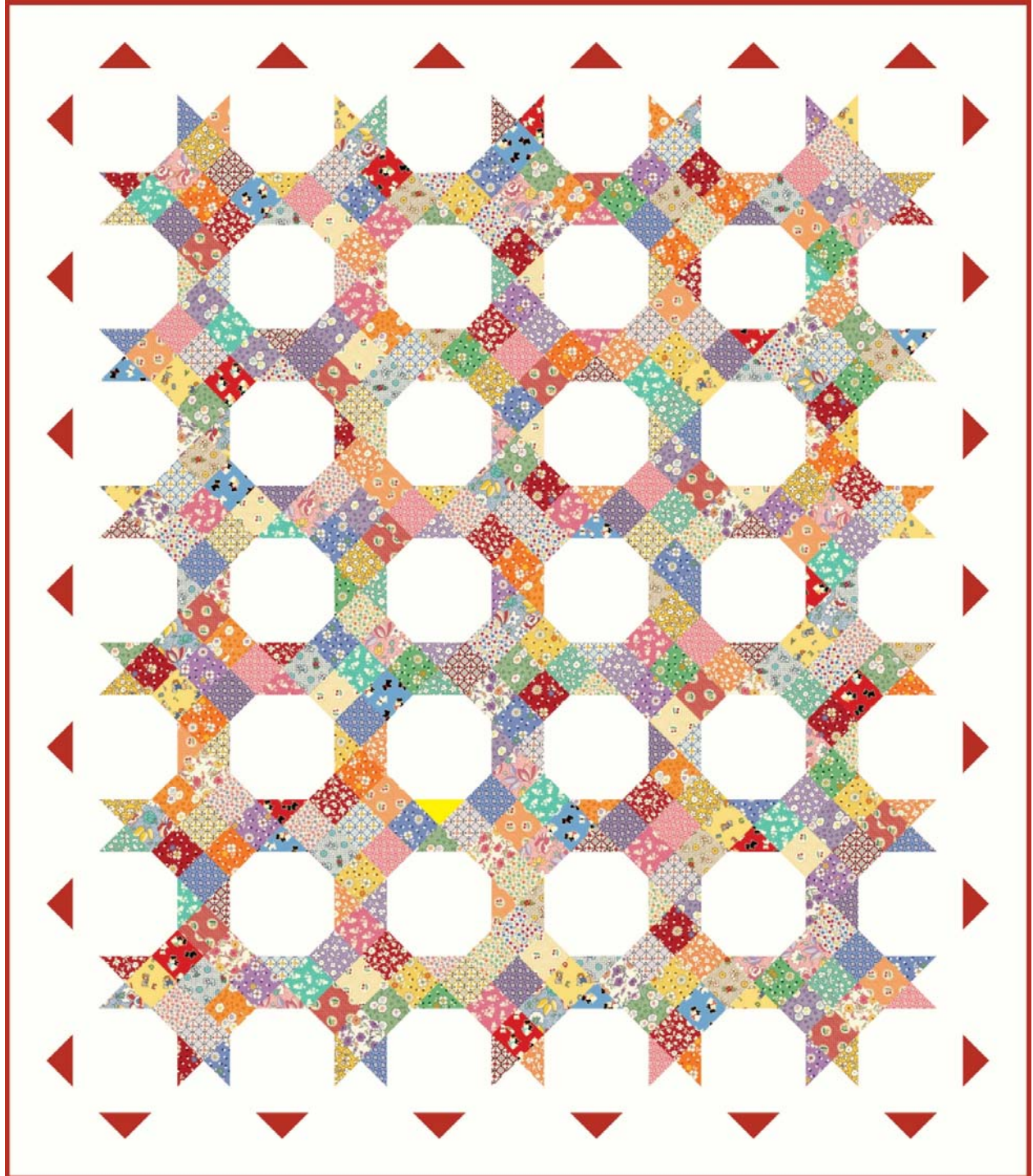


# Aunt Grace

Fabric by Judie Rothermel



55½" x 64"

Finished Quilt Size: 55-1/2" x 64"

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS AND CUTTING GUIDE:****1 Aunt Grace Fat Eighth Pack**

Cut a **total** of 412 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (270 for 9-patch blocks; 142 for snowball blocks – draw a diagonal line on the *wrong side* of these squares)

**Marshmallow – 2 1/2 yards (0733)**

Cut 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 60" **length of fabric** (border)

Cut 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" **length of fabric** (border)

Cut 6 squares, 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" – cut twice diagonally (setting triangles)

Cut 2 squares, 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" – cut once diagonally (corner triangles)

Cut 42 squares, 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (snowball blocks)

**1930's Red – 3/4 yard (0020)**

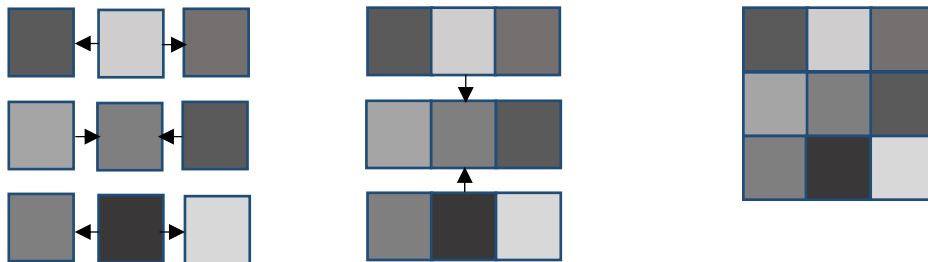
249" of a continuous 2 1/4" strip (binding)

Cut 26 squares, 2 1/2" – draw a diagonal line on the *wrong side* of each (22 of the snowball blocks)

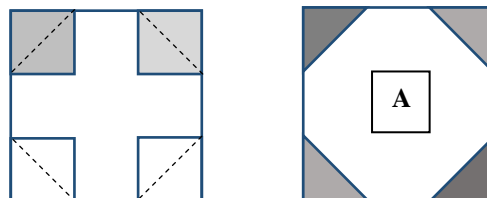
*All seams are sewn right sides together with a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise specified*

**Making the Nine-Patch Blocks: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (unfinished)**

Stitch 9 assorted 2 1/2" print squares together pressing towards the arrows. Make 30 of these blocks using a variety of the 2 1/2" print squares for each block.

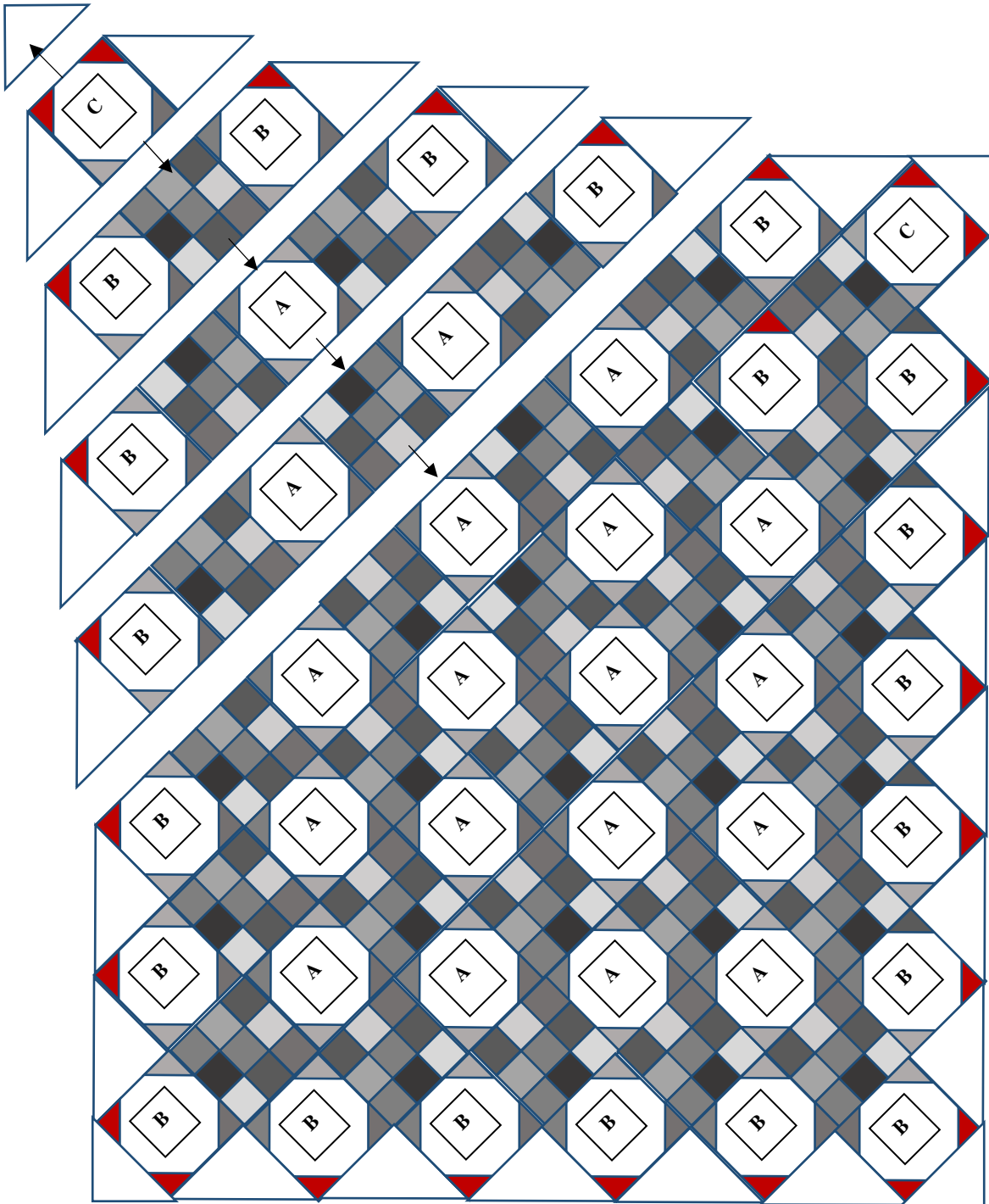
**Making the Snowball Blocks: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (unfinished)**

1. Lay a 2 1/2" assorted print square onto each corner of a 6 1/2" cream square, noting orientation of the drawn line. Stitch on the drawn line, trim and press to the print. Make 20 Snowball Block A.



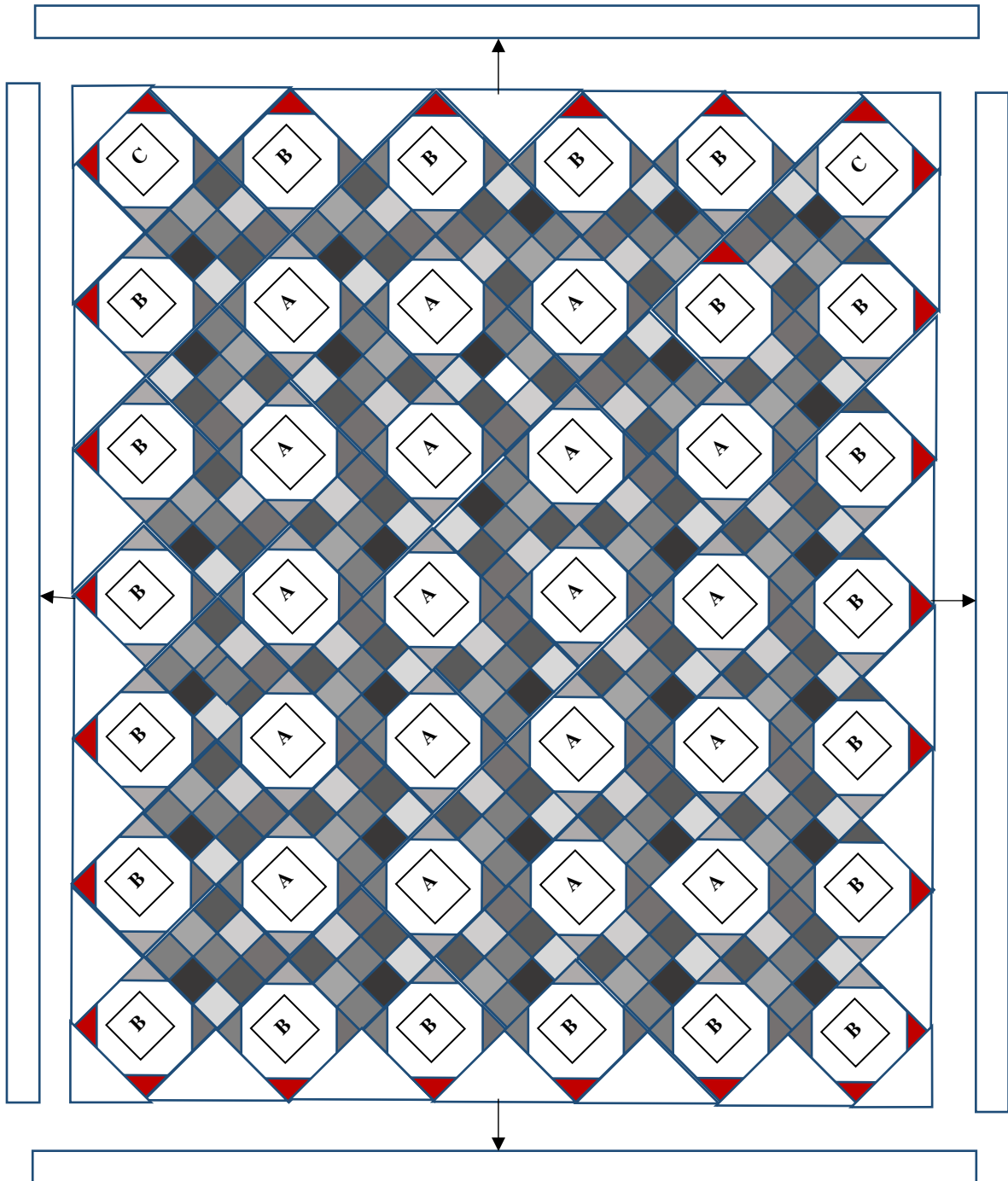


4. Stitch the Nine-Patch blocks, the Snowball blocks, and the setting triangles together in diagonal rows, pressing towards the triangles and Nine-Patch blocks





5. Stitch a 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" cream border strip to each side of the quilt, pressing to the border. Stitch a 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" cream border to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Quilt as desired and bind with the 2 1/4" red binding strip.
