

Easy Jelly Roll Throw

65 x 75

1. Take a jelly roll and sew the 2½" strips end-to-end with diagonal seams. (A jelly roll containing 40 strips would be about 1600 feet long!!)
2. Trim diagonal seams to reduce bulk and press in one direction. Cut 18" from the first strip and discard.
3. Bring the two ends together, right sides together with NO twists in the strips. Sew the long sides together. Your strip will now be about 800 feet long.
4. Clip the folded end, so that you can open the strip and press the seam in one direction.
5. Again, bring the short ends together and sew the long sides right sides together. Repeat these steps over and over until you have 32 strips in width. Notice that each time you fold the strip length in half, the seams become much easier to sew. Your quilt is now ready to be squared up.

Optional Borders: Add an inner border (3/8 yd) of 6 - 2" strips. Add sides first, then top and bottom. Add an outer border (1 1/8 yd) 7 - 5½" strips. Binding (5/8 yard) 7 - 2½" strips.



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
