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Vintage Christmas Fabrics from the Vintage Christmas collection by Clothworks

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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 Panel - Panel (Y1010-2)
- 3/4 Yd - Cream Stripe (Y1011-2)
- 1/2 Yd - Red Tonal (Y1012-4)
- 1/4 Yd - Dk. Yellow Tonal (Y1012-10)
- 1/4 Yd - Dk. Olive Tonal (Y1012-25)
- 5/8 Yd - Lt. Olive Ornaments (Y1013-23)
- 1 Yd - Cream Tossed Words (Y1014-2)
- 1/2 Yd - Red Tossed Words (Y1014-4)
- 1/4 Yd - Olive Tossed Words (Y1014-24)
- 2 3/4 Yds - backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Cream Stripe cut:

- 1 – 5 1/2" LOF fussy cut Stockings
- 1 – 5 1/2" LOF fussy cut Ornaments

From the Red Tonal cut:

- 5 – 2 1/2" WOF strips (Binding)

From the Dk. Yellow Tonal cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 6 – 2 1/2" squares
- 12 – 2 7/8" squares

From the Dk. Olive Tonal cut:

- 12 – 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Lt. Olive Ornaments cut:

- 5 – 3 1/2" WOF strips (Outer Border)

From the Cream Tossed Words cut:

- 48 – 2 1/2" squares
- 24 – 2 7/8" squares
- 44 – 3 1/2" squares
- 4 – 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From the Red Tossed Words cut:

- 6 – 2 1/2" squares
- 12 – 2 7/8" squares
- 4 – 2 1/4" WOF strips (Inner Border)

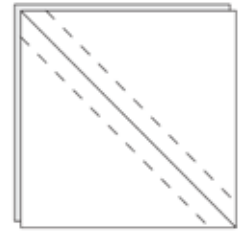
From the Olive Tossed Words cut:

- 10 – 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Directions

Star Blocks

1. With a pencil, mark the diagonal on the wrong side of each 2 7/8" Cream Tossed Words square.
2. With right sides together, place a 2 7/8" Cream Tossed Words square on top of a 2 7/8" Red Tossed Words square. Sew 1/4" from each side of the pencil line.
3. Cut the square in half along the pencil line to produce 2 half-square triangles. Make 4 half-square triangles for each block. (Diagram 1)
4. Arrange the 2 1/2" Cream Tossed Words squares, half-square triangle units, and 2 1/2" Red Tossed Words square as shown in Diagram 2.
5. Sew the units together in each row, then sew the rows together to complete the block. The block should measure 6 1/2" square.
6. Make 6 Red Tossed Words/Cream Tossed Words blocks.
7. Repeat Steps 1-5 to make 6 Dk. Yellow Tonal/Cream Tossed Words blocks.
8. Sew 3 Red Star blocks & 3 Dk. Yellow Star blocks, beginning with a red block and alternating with a Dk. Yellow block to create a Star Block border.
9. Repeat Step 8 to make a 2nd Star Block border.

Tree Blocks

1. With a pencil, mark the diagonal on the wrong side of each 3 1/2" Cream Tossed Words square.
2. With right sides together, place a 3 1/2" Cream Tossed Words square on one side of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Dk. Olive Tonal rectangle.
3. Sew on the pencil line. Trim away the corner leaving a 1/4" allowance. (Diagram 3)
4. Repeat step 2-3 on the other side of the Dk. Olive Tonal rectangle to make a flying geese unit. (Diagram 4)
5. Make 12 Dk. Olive Tonal flying geese units. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make 10 Olive Tossed Words flying geese units.
6. Sew together 6 Dk. Olive Tonal units & 5 Olive Tossed Words units, beginning with a Dk. Olive Tonal unit and alternating with an Olive Tossed Words units to create a Tree Block unit.
7. Sew a 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cream Tossed Words rectangle to each side of a 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Dk. Yellow Tonal unit to create the tree trunk. The unit should measure 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" when finished. Sew to the bottom of the Tree unit.
8. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make a 2nd Tree Block border.

Putting it Together

1. Trim the Panel to 21" x 23".
2. Refer to the color picture on the front for border placements.
3. Cut the 2 1/4" Red Tossed Words WOF strips to make 2 - 2 1/4" x 23" rectangles and 2 - 2 1/4" x 24 1/2" rectangles.
4. Sew a 2 1/4" x 23" Red Tossed Words strip to each side of the Panel. Sew a 2 1/4" x 24" Red Tossed Words strip to the top and bottom of the Panel.
5. Fussy cut the Cream Stripe into 2 - 24 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. One will feature the stockings and the other will feature the Ornaments.
6. Sew the 24 1/2" x 5 1/2" Ornament stripe to the top of the quilt and the 24 1/2" x 5 1/2" Stocking stripe to the bottom of the quilt.
7. Sew a Tree Block border to each side of the quilt. Trim the "tree trunk" end of this border if it is longer than the quilt center.
8. Sew a Star Block border to the top and bottom of the quilt.
9. Sew the 3 1/2" Lt. Olive Ornament WOF strips together end-to-end. Cut the strips into 2 - 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" rectangles and 2 - 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangles.
10. Sew a 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" rectangle to each side of the quilt. Sew a 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Finish the Quilt

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired
2. Apply the binding to the quilt.
