DAY #2 - STRIPES

During our Stars & Stripes event we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew & stitch into a darling quilt! FABRIC:

- 3 Red Print
- 3 Cream Prints

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From red prints:

- Random lengths of 1 ½ inch strips to total about 100 inches

From cream prints:

- (3) 1 ½ X 12 ½ inch strips
- (2) 1 ½ X 18 ½ inch strips

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The red stripes on our flag are scrappy. Sew the random red print strips together, end for end, and cut into (3) 12 ½" long strips, and (3) 18 ½ inch strips.
2. Refer to color diagram, arrange the 12 ½" cream print & red print strips into the top right section of the flag. Stitch the strips together. Arrange the 18 ½" cream print & red print strips into the lower section of the flag. Stitch the strips together.
3. Along with the 4 star block from Day 1, arrange the stripe units into the flag. Sew together. See you tomorrow!
