FINISHED SIZE IS 24 X 32 INCHES

FABRIC:

- Cream Print
- Variety of Colors used in spool blocks
- Black Print

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From cream print:

- (42) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ X 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

From variety of colors:

- (42) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ X 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares

From black print:

- (2) 3 X 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips
- (2) 3 X 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips
- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches X width of fabric

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. To make the half square triangle blocks (hst), draw a diagonal line on the back of the cream print 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares.

2. Layer a marked square, right sides together, with a colored square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, press.
3. Repeat with all cream print and colored squares to get 84 hst blocks.
4. Sew the hst blocks into 2 strips of 17 blocks, and 2 strips of 25 blocks.
5. Sew the 25 block strips to the left and right side of the previously assembled quilt center.
6. To both ends of the 17 blocks strips, sew a cream 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew those units to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
7. Sew a black print 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center.
8. Sew a black print 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
9. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing; baste.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Bind quilt. Enjoy!
