FABRIC:

- Green Print #1 * 1/8th yard
- Green Print #2 * 1/8th yard
- Black Print * Fabric scrap

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Trimming the Blocks:

4 Corner House Blocks

- Trim blocks to 8.5 X 8.5 inches square.

Top (Spring) & Bottom (Fall) Blocks:

- Trim blocks to 8.5 H X 14.5 W inches.

Left (Winter) & Right (Summer) Side Blocks:

- Trim blocks to 8.5 W X 17.5 H inches.

Center (Home Sweet Home) Block:

- Trim block to 12.5 W X 15.5 H inches.

From print fabric cut:

- (4) 1.5 X 1.5 inch squares

CENTER BORDER INSTRUCTIONS:

For Borders Around Center Block:

Make (54) 1" Finished half square triangle blocks. Using half square triangle paper, or your favorite method to make 1" finished half square triangle

blocks, place green print fabric #1 & green print fabric #2 with right sides together. Lay half square triangle paper on top of set of fabric and follow manufacturers sewing instructions.

- Referring to color photo, sew (12) half square triangle units together for top & bottom borders.
- Sew (15) half square triangle units together for the side borders.
- Sew a 1.5 inch black fabric square to both ends of the 12 half square triangle unit strips.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Sew the 15 half square triangle unit strips to the left & right sides of the center block. Sew the remaining half square triangle strips to the top & bottom of the center block.
2. Arrange center block and all applique blocks into quilt center. Sew the blocks into 3 rows. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the quilt center.
