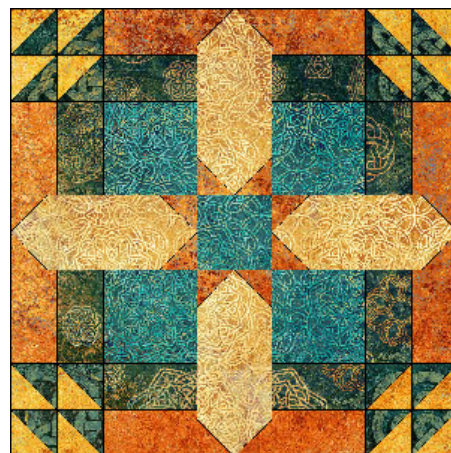

Class Policies:

- **Sign ups will begin on February 2**
- You may only sign up two people for each class/event (i.e. yourself & a friend)
- Class fee must be paid at time of registration.
- **Telephone registrations will be held for one week.**
- Please get supply lists in advance. Most classes require some preparation.
- Please purchase supplies at our shop. (This helps if there is a cutting “oops” and you need more fabric!)

Techniques include half-square triangles, flying geese, and a couple of unusual but simple piecing steps—great for learning new skills or honing skills you possess. Kit purchase required. Things are Looking Up— This cute snowman wallhanging will help you improve your skills with machine applique! Pattern Purchase required. March 9 10-4 with Valerie \$25.00
