## Supply List for Landscape Art Quilt Class rev 5/2023

Your class fee includes a kit corresponding to the inspiration photo you have chosen from the options provided. (See photos on back.) The kit will be prepared with an assortment of batik fabrics, prints, and tulle.

## **BEFORE YOU ARRIVE FOR CLASS**

- Install your Free Motion Quilting foot and a fresh <u>TOPSTITCH needle</u>, size 90/14., This is not the same as a universal, or quilting, or microtex needle. The correct needles are available at InterQuilten.
- Cut a piece of low loft cotton batting about 11 x 14 inches. No high loft or poly batting. Cut a backing fabric about 13 x 16 inches.

## What else you must bring to the class:

- You will need a large extension table for your machine. In the event you do not have a large extension table, you will need to bring boxes or books which can be placed beside, in back, and in front of your machine, in order to create a large flat area level with your machine bed.
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade (45 mm or 60 mm size), and a self healing cutting mat: 18 x 24 inches is preferred. You can make do with a 12 x 18 if necessary.
- Scissors
- Lots of pins straight pins or curved basting pins.
- Thread for stitching: The preferred thread is a 100wt poly called Invisafil. This is available at InterQuilten, and the color or colors needed will not be selected until your art quilt is ready for stitching. Clear Mono Poly can be used, but is not ideal.

Also highly recommended: Quilting Gloves; a Grid Glider for your machine (Sew Slip, or Supreme Slider will also work in lieu of a Grid Glider.)

## On the day of class

Come prepared. Plan to arrive 10 minutes before the class start time so you can be set up and ready by 10am.

Turn cell phones off or turn to silent.

Feel free to bring a drink, as long as the container has a cover. There are many quick lunch options nearby, or feel free to bring a lunch.
