

## Landscape Art Quilt Class with Fabric Kit

Our Landscape Art Quilt begins with the selection of an inspiration photo. You can choose to work from one of our photos (the kit for this is included in the class fee) or, you may use a photo you bring (additional kit fee of \$8 applies).

**If you are selecting your own photo, you must bring or send your desired photo to Tawni for approval at least one week (or more) prior to class. Call ahead and set up a time to come in and see Tawni with your photo, or email it to [tawni@interquiltten.com](mailto:tawni@interquiltten.com).** We will approve photos which are a good fit for the class. We ask for a week in advance to give you time to find another if your first choice is not right for the class. Look for a photo with a background, mid-ground and foreground area. Ideally, there should be trees in your photo. Please do not ask to use a photo with running water (rushing river, waterfall), snow, or one with people or buildings. Calm water, such as a lake, is OK. Do not bring photos of a painting or artwork by another person. It should be a photo of an actual place. When you come to class, you will need to have the image printed on paper.

All kits include: Batiks chosen for the inspiration photo you choose. (For each color, you will likely need a variety of hues and/or values: lights, mediums, and darks, cools and warms); Textural prints for trees; Tulle.

### Supplies to bring to class

Backing fabric cut 13" x 16" **Please cut your backing before arriving for class.**

Thin cotton batting (no high loft or poly batting) cut to 11" x 14" **Please cut your batting before arriving for class.**

Cutting Mat, Rotary cutter with fresh blade (each student will need their own – no sharing)

Scissors, pins (straight pins or curved basting pins).

**Before coming to class**, install a new **Topstitch needle**, size 90/14, in your sewing machine, and install your free motion quilting foot (sometimes called a "darning foot").

Thread: The correct thread will be available for purchase at the class. **Recommended thread is Invisafil, by Wonderfil, a 100 wt poly thread.** As an alternative, you may choose to try a poly invisible thread, such as Monopoly by Superior, in clear or smoke. *Nylon monofilament or the classic "invisible" thread is not recommended.*

If you have an extension table for your machine, bring it. If not, or if your extension table is small, bring a couple of boxes or some things that can be placed around the machine to create a large surface approximately even with the bed of your machine. You will need ample flat space to the left and in back of your sewing machine, at a height very similar to your sewing machine's bed.

### On the Day of Class

You will need to wear a face mask to enter the shop.

Plan to arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled class time. Please be set up and ready to begin by 10am.

Turn cell phones off or put on silent.

Feel free to bring in a drink (with a cover, please).

There are many quick lunch options nearby, or feel free to bring a lunch.
