A Place for Everything Pattern by Annie (required)  
Fabric and supplies as listed on pattern cover  
Thread to match fabrics

Sewing machine in good working order, **with walking foot, 1/4" foot and zipper foot.**  
If you have a Teflon foot for your machine, bring it too, to facilitate stitching on the vinyl.  
Remember the extension table for your machine!

Rotary cutter, rulers and mat.

Basic sewing kit including:

90/14 Topstitch needles

Wonder Clips

A Stiletto/pressing tool

Pins

Scissors

Thread

Chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines

Washable school glue stick

### Before Class:

To make the best use of class time, please cut out the fabric pieces and quilt the fabric pieces according to the instructions on page 2 of the pattern BEFORE coming to class. Please complete ALL the steps on page 2 before class.

### Pat's Suggestions/Recommendations

- Prewind several bobbins of all colors for quick switches and saving time
- Recommend light to medium weight vinyl, the heavy duty vinyl is challenging to work with
- If pre-cutting vinyl, suggest for style 1&2, cut 7" x 14". For style 3&4, cut 5" x 14", then trim after sewing
- Precut and glue template onto cardboard for folding vinyl (photocopy template to preserve original pattern)
- Bring extra Wonder Clips

It is strongly suggested that you purchase your class supplies at Cotton Patch Shop to ensure you have the proper items.
