On page 16 the Material quantities are listed.

Some adjustments are:

1 yard of fusible web – I use Heat n Bond or Sew Lazy fusible

Rickrack is an option. Other items can be used or a decorative stitch to form the line.

Backing and binding can be purchased now or later.

Additional items to bring:

Sewing machine with quarter inch foot, power cord and foot pedal. If you have a knee lifter that is a good tool in appliqué sewing.

Threads:

Piecing thread for top and bobbin

Coordinating 40 – 50 wt threads for the appliqué fabrics.

A fine point Sharpie pen

Scissors for cutting paper backed fabric, rotary cutter with new blade, ruler 8 ½' x 12 ½".

Class Prep:

On page 17 follow the cutting instructions for the background pieces. If comfortable proceed with tracing the appliqué patterns on the paper side of the fusible web.

Be sure to leave a minimum quarter inch between traced patterns. **If cutting them out Do Not cut on the traced line, cut at least a quarter inch around the pieces.**
