

## HIP ST. NICK

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### Revised Supply List: (11/12/18)

Hip St. Nick Pattern by Hunter's Design Studio

Please see pattern for fabric requirements. I did try to cover these below, but you may want to make changes.

$\frac{3}{4}$  yard of background fabric

$\frac{3}{8}$  yard white,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard for face color,  $\frac{1}{8}$  yard red,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of red and white,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard for border,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard for binding (if binding), 2  $\frac{2}{3}$  yard pom poms if using instead of binding. 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  strip for mustache, 5" square for nose and 5" square for eyes.

$\frac{2}{3}$  yard backing and batting

Sewing machine in good working order with foot pedal and cords, have bobbin wound and a new needle bring your sewing machine manual for trouble shooting

Foundation paper piecing paper ([I am recommending Simple Foundations Translucent Vellum Paper for this project. This paper allows you to see more clearly the fabrics behind it.](#))

Add  $\frac{1}{4}$  ruler

$\frac{1}{4}$  " foot and open toe foot

6" X 24" ruler

Neutral thread for piecing

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade

Your regular sewing notions, scissors, seam ripper, needles, straight pins and/or clips etc.

### Prior to Class

Read over pattern

Press fabric with starch or an alternative for the best results.

Copy all pieces on foundation paper. Do not cut out after copying.

It is strongly suggested that you purchase your class supplies at Cotton Patch Shop to ensure you have the proper items.
