My Kinda Town pattern (must be your own)

Bring entire pattern with you to first class. Have blocks 1 and 2 cut into sections (each block is divided into numbered sections and subdivided into alphabetical components).

You may sew directly on the pattern pieces.

I scanned my components at 100% onto foundation paper piecing paper such as Carol Doak's. The pattern is a heavier paper.

Ziplock bags (I used gallon size)

Bring a 45mm rotary cutter with new blade,

Add a Quarter ruler, 6.5 x 12 or 24 inch ruler, personal cutting mat (or use the shops), stiletto, fabric scissors, paper scissors, seam ripper, marking tools, pencil, fine pins, clips if you prefer, fabric glue stick, and a seam roller if you like using one.

Fabric for backgrounds and fat quarters, fat eights, and even scraps. The shop has a bin of scraps that you may purchase by the bag full.

Sewing machine with all necessary cords and the foot pedal, open toe foot, 1/4" foot, manual, machine needles 12/80 or 14/90 top stitch or micro, sewing machine oil if your machine uses it.

(You may need to oil your machine more often since you are sewing through paper and you will definitely need to change your needle more often too.)

Since this is all day you may bring your lunch or we can order. Please bring cash in small bills if you intend to order your lunch. Snacks are welcomed just nothing messy please.
