

Stitcher's Garden Supply List and Schedule

Wednesday's on January 10th and 24th, February 7th and 21st, March 7th and 21st, and April 4th. 10am to 4pm

For each class you will need various colors of threads for appliqueing, (invisible thread may also be used), Steam A Seam 2 or other fusible web, general sewing supplies, sewing machine, your manual, rotary cutter, small scissors, spray starch, water soluble fabric marker, one sheet of template plastic (this will be enough for all classes), and background fabric and batting. White double cotton batting will be available for sale at the store.

A three ring binder and plastic sheet protectors are an excellent way of staying organized and keeping your directions and templates together.

Fabric kits for each block will be available for purchase at Cotton Patch. You must register for kits by January 3rd. Cost of kit is \$120. Kits will be distributed at the beginning of each class.

If you are using your own fabric bring enough fabric for two 8 to 12 inch blocks to each class.

Registration is \$45 and includes 5yds of background fabric that will be provided at the first class.

See below for other specific items needed for each class. A color photo of individual blocks will be provided at the first class.

Week 1 - January 24

Blocks 1 and 2

Feet - Open toe foot, edge foot, and Quilting guide (this looks like a J or L attached to a long bar)

Week 2 - February 7

Blocks 3 and 4

Feet - Circular attachment, Couching foot, and optional button foot

Embroidery Floss for frames (one skein)

Large yo-yo maker

Week 3 - February 21

Blocks 5 and 6

Feet - Couching foot, optional Candlewick foot or open toe foot, and Cording foot

Large yo-yo maker

Week 4 - March 7

Blocks 7 and 8

Feet - 7 or 5 Groove Pintuck Foot and Piping foot

Twin needles, 2.0, 2.5, 4.0

Embroidery Floss

Optional - Piping Tool and 1/2" bias maker

Large yo-yo maker

Week 5 - March 21

Blocks 9 and 10

Feet - Fringe Foot and Bobbin Work Bobbin

Week 6 - April 4

Blocks 11 and 12

Chenille Foot or open toe foot and Machine Embroidery unit or Traditional Applique

Green Blooming Bias 42" available from Cotton Patch

Chenille Brush

Small yo-yo maker

Heat Transfer pencil

1/8" ribbon, rick rack, small cording or embroidery floss

2- 3/4" buttons

3- 7/8" buttons
