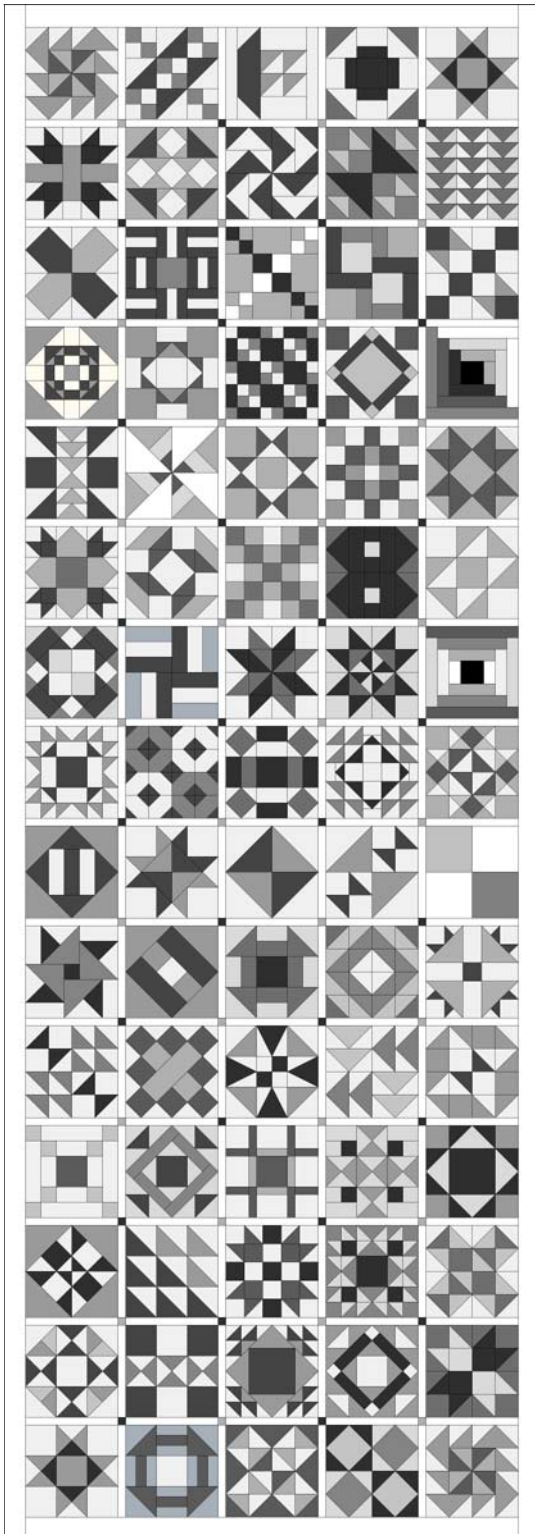




# Bible Studies Bed Runner

35"x100"



Use	Fabric Needed
Outer Border & Sashing Strips	1-1/4 yards Cut (22) 1" strips into (130) 1"x6-1/2" sashing strips Cut (7) 2" strips for outer border
Cornerstones	1/8 yard Dark & 1/8 yard Medium -Cut (1) 1" strip from each into (28) 1" squares
Binding	5/8 yard -Cut (7) 2-1/2" binding strips
Backing	3 yards

Image shown: bed runner is turned on its side.

## Instructions:

1. Lay out your blocks in the order of your choice: 5 horizontal rows of 15 blocks each. (Quilt shown is in order of the books of the Bible with Genesis repeated in the opposite corner and Ezra repeated in opposite corners.)
2. Stitch a 1"x6-1/2" sashing strip between each block as shown. Press toward the sashing strips. Construct 5 horizontal rows.

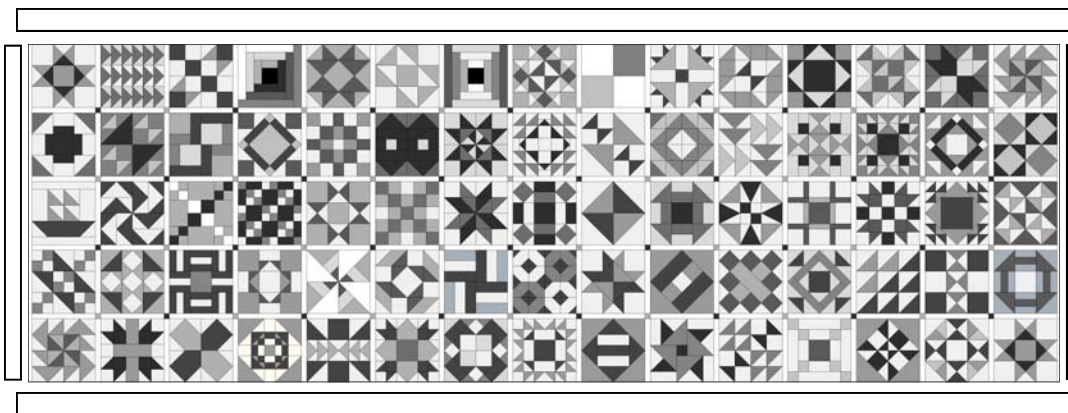


# Bible Studies Bed Runner

35"x100"

## Instructions (continued):

- Construct (4) sashing rows, alternating sashing strips and cornerstones as shown. Press toward the sashing strips. 
- Stitch the block rows and sashing rows together to complete the quilt top. Press toward the sashing rows.



- Measure the length of your quilt top through the center of your quilt. Depending on your individual seam allowance, your quilt top should measure approximately 32-1/2" long. Stitch together 2" border strips and cut (2) pieces to length. Stitch to each side of the quilt top.
- Measure the width of your quilt top through the center of your quilt. Depending on your individual seam allowance, your quilt top should measure approximately 100-1/2" wide. Stitch together 2" border strips and cut (2) pieces to width. Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Complete the quilt top by stitching the top and bottom outer borders on. Press toward the outer borders.
- Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
- Stitch binding strips together. Bind the quilt.
