

## Pocket Prayer Quilt

You will need:

- (2) 2" X 2" Dark fabrics
  - (2) 2" X 2" Light fabrics
  - (1) 3 ½" X 3 ½" Backing fabric
  - (1) 3 ½" X 3 ½" Batting
  - (1) cross charm
- Pocket prayer

1. Sew (1) 2" X 2" dark square to (1) 2" X 2" light square. Press to the dark. Repeat.
2. Sew units made in Step #1 together to make a 4 patch alternating light and dark squares. Press.
3. Place batting on table. Lay 3 ½" X 3 ½" backing on top of batting with right side up. Lay 4 patch unit right side down on top of backing.
4. Sew around outer edge using a ¼" seam allowance and leave a 1 ½" opening. Trim corners. Turn inside out. Press.
5. Drop cross charm into opening of pocket quilt.
6. Lay paper pocket prayer on top of 4 patch and sew the paper prayer to the pocket quilt. (Sew the seam over the side with the opening so you close the opening while sewing on the pocket prayer.)

This ***"Pocket Prayer Quilt"***

was made especially for you to slip into your pocket. Throughout the day when your fingers touch the cross that is tucked inside the quilt, be mindful of God's love and grace for you. Keep it as a tangible symbol of God's presence and a reminder of prayers that are being said for you each day.
