



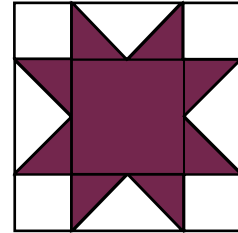

Mini Cakes Quilt

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 18" x 24"

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 6"

DESIGNED, PIECED BY FRAN CARTER



Fabric Requirements:

Background: 1/2 yard

One square makes two blocks: 11" x 11"

Cutting Directions for one block:

From the background fabric:

1 square, 3 7/8" cut on one diagonal

2 rectangles, 2" x 3 1/2"

2 squares 2 3/8"

2 squares 2"

From the blue fabric:

1 square 3 7/8" cut on one diagonal

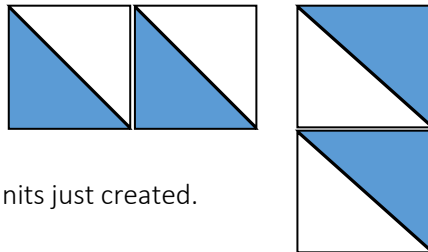
2 squares 2 3/8"

1 square 2 3/8" cut on one diagonal

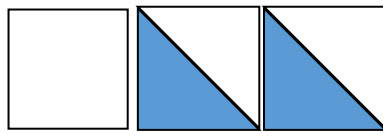
Piecing directions for one block are on the following pages.

Block and Quilt Assembly: (Directions refer to the reproduction version and you will need to adapt them for the modern version)

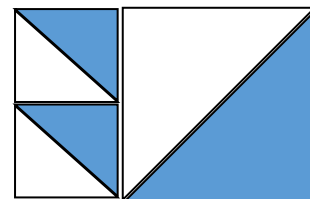
1. Draw a line on one diagonal on the back of a $2\frac{3}{8}$ " background square. Place right sides together with a blue $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create 2 half-square triangle units. Sew these two units together as shown. Repeat to create 2 units just like this.



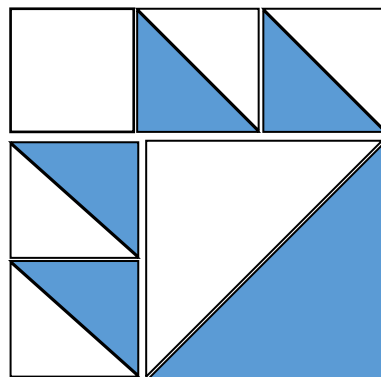
2. Sew a 2" square to one of the units just created.



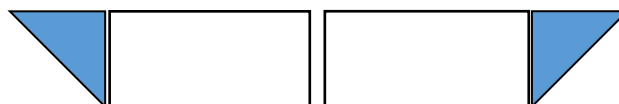
3. Sew one triangle made from the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " background square to one triangle made from the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " blue square. Then sew to unit created above.



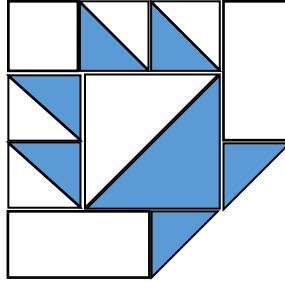
4. Sew units from step 3 and step 4 together



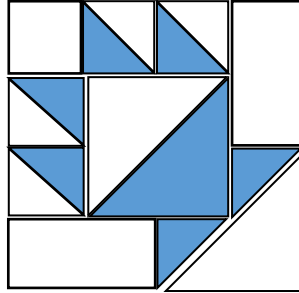
5. Sew one triangle cut from the $2\frac{3}{8}$ " blue square to the end of one background rectangle. Repeat to create 2 units just like this.



- Sew the two rectangle units to the main unit.



- Add final background triangle.



- Make 6 or 12 blocks and assemble in rows with or without alternate squares cut at $6 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Layer the top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
