



## Summer Fashion Design Camp Supplies List for the **Back to School Jacket**

**FABRICS FOR YOUR JACKET:** These will be used together to create your cool jacket. **No stretchy stuff!**

\_\_\_ 2 yards of fabric for the outer layer of your jacket, such as quilting cotton, soft denim, corduroy, satin, or twill, etc. Choose a fabric that will give your jacket its main “look” – dressy, flashy, sporty, frilly or urban cool

\_\_\_ 2 yards of plain color or small patterned fabric for the inner layer, such as quilting cotton, broadcloth, or satin, etc. This can be either a bright flashy contrast color or a matching shade for your other fabric.

**TRIMMINGS TO EMBELLISH YOUR JACKET:** Go flashy, frilly, edgy, or plain ‘n simple. It’s your choice!  
Choose any or all of these for your special “Look” It’s not necessary to get *everything!* Just the stuff you like.

\_\_\_ 2 ½ yards of decorative trim, such as pom poms, fringe, lace, ruffles, wide ribbon, or flat braided trim

\_\_\_ A small assortment of buttons, beads, applique patches, etc. to sew on your jacket

\_\_\_ 3 to 5 sheets of craft felt, 9”X12” Choose all one color or a mix. These will be used to make appliques to decorate your jacket with fancy pockets or other shapes (hearts, butterflies, flowers, bold shapes, etc.)

\_\_\_ ½ yard tulle – This is optional. Get it only if you want to learn to work with this weird stuff!

\_\_\_ Two large spools of all-purpose thread – any 2 colors that look good with your fabrics. More colors are ok, too!

\_\_\_ Clear Ruler 2” x 18” with a 1/8” grid to help you draft your pattern. Put your name on it!

\_\_\_ **Bring Your Sewing Box with basic sewing tools:** fabric scissors, trimming scissors, quilter’s pins, seam gauge, seam ripper, tape measure, fabric marking pencils (or chalk), hand needles, pin cushion

**REMINDER!** Be sure your name is on your sewing box and your tools.
