Class Supplies Needed:

Sewing machine ($\frac{1}{4}$ " foot highly recommended)	Fairie Wings pattern
Size 70 (Microtex sharp) sewing machine needles	by: Judy and Brad Niemeyer
Thread - 50 wt high quality thread in neutral color	Purple Thang
Rotary Cutter (with both old and new blades)	Seam Ripper
Rotary Cutting Rulers (3" x 18" and 8½" x 24")	Scissors (fabric and paper)
Add-A-Quarter rulers - 6" and 12"	Template plastic (fold template)
Rotary Mat (at least 18" x 24")	Curved Scissors
Sewline washable fabric glue pen (fabric)	Fabric glue pen refills (lots)
UHU or Elmer's Disappearing Purple glue stick (paper)	Extra Fine straight pins (sew)
Repositionable Glue Stick**	Sharpie pen (medium)
Tweezers (optional)	

* if your $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot has a guide on it, please replace that foot with a standard (no guide) $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot

** to be provided at class.

Pre-Class Preparation: Read through the first six (6) pages of the instructions (you may not understand them but the more you read them the quicker they will begin to make sense). This is a "first timer" (for paper piecing) class so the first class will explain the specifics. There will be in-class demonstrations for speed cutting papers (you should cut papers for the Group J - Mosaic Star section if you are comfortable after reading the general instructions).

If you are taking this class and have some "Judy experience," then you should pre-cut all your papers and pre-cut your fabrics for Group J prior to the first class so you can get started immediately. With that said, do not feel pressured to get anything done prior to class if your schedule does not permit.
