The Log Cabin Ruler (there are several) by Jean Ann Wright for Creative Grids makes fast work of the traditional log cabin. You no longer have to spend hours precision cutting your planks. With these rulers you trim as you go so every block is a perfect block upon completion. The 4", 8", and 10" Duo Trimming Rulers will be demonstrated in class. None of the curvy or wavy options will be used.

Class Supplies Needed:

Sewing machine ($\frac{1}{4}$ " foot highly recommended)*	Log Cabin Ruler (4" and 8")
Size 70 (sharp) sewing machine needles	Fabric - scraps (include neutrals)
Thread - 50 wt high quality thread in neutral color	at least 2" wide OR
Rotary Cutter (with new blades)	see below for placemat fabrics
Rotary Cutting rulers (3" x 18" or 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24")	Straight pins (extra fine)
Rotary Mat (at least 12" x 28")	Seam Ripper
Sewline washable fabric glue pen (fabric)	

*if your $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot has a guide on it, please replace that foot with a standard (no guide) $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot

Class Preparation: None - WooHoo

For the Placemat, you will need (2) neutral strips measuring 2" x 42" and (14) strips of (7) colors or accent fabrics (2 strips each) measuring 2" x 42" You will find log cabins are a great scrap buster.
