

Jellyroll Twist Quilt Serger Class

Come and join Cynthia G for a fun serger quilt class. In this class you will learn how to piece a quilt top quickly with your serger's 4-Thread Overlock Stitch OR create specialty topstitching effects all the while joining your strips with the 2-Thread Flatlock stitch. I will also teach you how to join batting scraps and how to join and apply binding to your quilt sandwich with your serger. You will only need a jellyroll and a charm pack for this class or yardage cut into 5" squares.

Class Supplies

- Jellyroll (we will be using 34 strips) Sort these into 17 sets of two and clip together. These will be joined together to make strips sets.
- A charm pack (you will need 42 squares.) If using yardage, you need 7/8 of a yard. I suggest a neutral color such as white, cream, gray or black. Or a solid or blender color that coordinates with your jellyroll strips. Cut it into 5"x5". You will need 42 squares.
- Serger Thread (4 spools) Good Quality such as Maxi Lock, 30 WT or Tex 45 Thread for decorative top stitching. I recommend 2 to 4 colors.

***Note: I will have a variety of colors of serger thread and decorative thread for use during class.

***Note: Wawak.com is a good source to purchase thread of all kinds from.

- General Quilting rulers (especially 9.5”x 9.5” or bigger Square ruler) The Shop has some that you can use.
- Personal cutting and pressing mat and iron are helpful.
 - Rotary cutter
 - Seam ripper
 - Clips or pins
- Print out the pattern from the Jelly Roll Twist Pattern on the Fat Quarter Shop website under free patterns
