

MY FIRST QUILT

1. Using your corner square pairs, construct the four half-square triangle blocks. Press seams open.
2. Using your center square pair, construct the center block quarter-square triangle. Press seams open.
3. Using your 9 ½" square ruler, square up all blocks.
4. Sew rows together. Row #1: one half-square triangle block (top left corner block), one 4 patch block, one half-square triangle block (right top corner).
5. Row #2: one 4 patch block, the quarter square triangle center block, another 4 patch block.
6. Row #3: one half-square triangle block (lower left corner), one 4 patch block, one half-square triangle block (lower right corner).
7. Sew Row 1 to Row 2, matching and nesting seams. Attach Row 3 in the same manner.
8. Sew your borders to quilt sides first and trim at edges. Repeat on top and bottom of quilt top. Press to the outside.
9. Run a long basting stitch around the edge of the quilt top.

STUDENT'S SUPPLY LIST

FABRIC: DIRECTIONAL FABRIC DESIGNS ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR THIS PROJECT.

Quilt top:

- (A) 1 yd medium to large, multi-colored print (focus fabric)
- (B) Five 1/3 yd cuts from fabrics that compliment your focus fabric.

RULERS:

- (a) 5, 6, or 6 1/2 x 24" long ruler
- (b) 9 1/2" square, AN ABSOLUTE MUST

THREAD: cotton thread in a neutral color. Please come to class with three bobbins wound.

OTHER SUPPLIES:

- Cutting Mat 15 x 23"
- Rotary Cutter 45mm with NEW blade
- Erasable marking pen
- Note paper and pen/pencil
- Package of 80/12 machine needles
- Flower head pins

SEWING MACHINE in good working order that you can thread, wind your bobbins and change a needle. Be sure to bring the instruction manual and all the cords, the pedal and machine accessories. If your machine has a 1/4" foot, also bring it to class along with your normal sewing supplies.

PLEASE IRON YOUR FABRICS BEFORE CLASS AND AND PLACE THEM ON HANGERS. LEAVE THE CENTERFOLD CREASE.
