MESSAGE FROM MAYOR CALLOWAY:

It's hard to believe we are coming up on the end of 2021, but looking forward to 2022 the town has a bright and busy future ahead of us. And here is some of what's coming up:

We are finalizing plans for a lower loop of the Manzanita trail which is one of my favorites in the summer. I will walk it several times a week, and if you have not hiked it I strongly encourage you to.

We have contracted with an artist to create an iconic art piece. "Brian The Bear" will be located at Bristlecone Park. We believe he will become social media star and help promote the town as well as add some polish and class.

The town is working with a developer named Gardner Plumb on the 1700 acres north of town. It's early in the planning stages but the vision is starting to come into focus. This may include multiple chair lifts and up to 1300 living units, a mix of hotel, condos and single family homes along with some commercial development, restaurant and shopping. They also plan to include walking and mountain bike trails to connect to existing trails. This would almost double the size of the town in both land mass and living units.

We will be saying goodbye to two of our council members -- Lynn Mulder and Shaun Kelly. I want to personally thank them for their service that has helped shape the future of our town. They both brought a unique perspective and balance to the council which will be missed. We will be welcoming Dennis Van Nostran and Martin Tidwell to the council. They have both served on the Planning Commission and I am looking forward to working with them. This will open up two seats on the Planning Commission. I am honored for the opportunity to serve another term as your mayor and want you to know I always welcome your input, good or bad. I know we may not always agree, but I do value your point of view.
