## PROJECTS

- Park/ Trail: 1. 20 Spruce Trees being planted around Bristlecone pond. 2. Rosenberg and Assoc. will begin design and engineering work for Phase II of Town Trail
- Streets: The 2020 Street Project will begin the week of June 8th Consolidated Paving and Concrete will be applying asphalt patching and a 1 inch overlay on Village Way with a Fog coat.
