



Brian Head Town Council meetings will now be online through Zoom Meetings

Effective March 30, 2020

In an effort to reduce the spread of the CVOID-19 virus by practicing social distancing, Brian Head Town will hold all Town Council meetings through Zoom Meetings, a video meeting site where the Council will hold their regularly scheduled meetings via video. The public can join to view Council meetings from the comfort of their homes by joining Zoom Meetings with an ID# for that meeting.

Brian Head Town will share a meeting link on the Town's website on the Town Calendar under the Council Meeting date and on the Utah Public Meeting Notice Website for each Council meeting scheduled. These links can be accessed on the Town's website: brianheadtown.utah.gov or pmw.utah.gov. The Town Council Agenda will identify the meeting ID# for each meeting. If you are unsure of the meeting ID#, please contact Nancy Leigh, Town Clerk, who will send you a link for a Council Meeting. Please note that each Council meeting will have a different meeting ID#.

In order to run an effective Council meeting, staff will be monitoring the meeting in which the Council and staff will be on video with the ability to speak. The public is welcome to join the meeting but will be muted during the Council meeting. Staff will be monitoring the chat box where the public may make comments and staff may bring it to the Council's attention, depending on the comment made. If the Mayor recognizes the person wanting to speak, the mute button will be lifted, and the person may make their comment. Please note, in order to make this an effective process, we ask the public to view the meeting and only make comments if necessary.
